Agrostis capillaris, *anthoxanthum odoratu*, *centaurea nigra*, *cynosurus cristatus*, *pestuca rubra*, *gallium verum*, *leontodon autumnalis*, *leontodon hispidus*, *leucanthemum vulgare*, *lotus corniculatus*, *pimpinella saxifraga*, *plantago lanceolata*, *poa pratensis*, *primula veris*, *trifolium pratense*, *ranunculus acris*, *ranunculus bulbosus*, *thlasminus minor*, *rumex acetosa*
